
A New Life

Imagine that you are an anthropologist.


Write a story about a time that you found an important artifact, fossil, bones or some clue about the past.


Interview With A Prehistoric Being

Write a newspaper article about the events that you saw during a day.








Make up a trivia question about something that you have learned during this unit.


Write the question on a cue card, supplied by your teacher.

Give the card to your teacher to add to the class collection of *Prehistoric Times Trivial Pursuit*. e.g.



Make a list of eight possible questions that you would ask this person.


What do you think the answers will be?

Creative Writing Card 15


Being A Prehistoric Creature
